The Role:

As the Management Systems Lead Internal Auditor you will be responsible for conducting internal audits in accordance with the Annual Audit Schedule for all Barhale Group activities. You will monitor deployment of our Integrated Management Systems and support the identification of risk and opportunities to enable continuous improvement. You will report to the HSEQ Systems and Audit Manager.

Key Responsibilities:

Auditing to monitor compliance with the Integrated Management System (IMS) requirements

- Conduct audits of company procedures in accordance with the Annual Audit Schedule
- Conduct audits with external Supply Chain partners
- Log audits and non-conformances onto the Management System
- · Provide audit reports to site teams
- Support and approve the timely closure of audit findings
- Support the HSEQ Systems and Audit Manager in compiling monthly reports on audit trends, root cause and opportunities for improvement

Advising and mentoring support to operational delivery teams

- Provide advice and mentoring support to site teams during internal audits to raise standards and understanding of IMS requirements and adoption.
- Advise site teams on how to close non-conformances, follow up audit responses and ensure effective review and closure.

Communication/meetings

- Attend monthly HSEQ Audit Meetings with the CFO, Director for HSEQ, Engineering Director and the HSEQ Systems and Audit Manager
- Attend weekly HSEQ Meetings via Teams
- Attend bi-monthly Quality Team Meetings

Support the HSEQ Systems and Audit Manager with external audits where required
